COMPETITIVE SWIMMER – Annual Membership \$185

Eligible to participate in all Club and Swimming WA events, includes **JUNIOR** and **NOVICE** swimmers 7-12 years, **AGE** group swimmers 13-18 years, **OPEN** swimmers 18 years/over, **OPEN WATER** swimmers and **MULTI-DISABILITY (MD)** swimmers of all ages. Entitled to participate in Swimming WA competitions and Interclub Challenges for all age and skill levels. Enjoy special events and social activities. Eligible for Club Awards, selection in Club Relay Teams and Club Premiership Team. Swimmers can also qualify to enter State, National & International events, attend Junior / Senior Swim Clinics and be invited to attend SWA Development Camps.

Family Concession – a discount is provided when a family has more than one competitive swimmer registered with the club at any one time. Discount schedule as follows; 2nd swimmer \$175, 3rd & 4th swimmer \$165 per person.

NON-SWIMMER/COACH/PARENT/OFFICIAL– Annual Membership \$10 (*No charge for Coaches)

Non-competitors do not swim and for insurance purposes, Swimming WA and Swan Hills Swimming Club request parents and/or guardians of athletes under 18 years, volunteers and officials register.

TRANSFER – \$30 Payable to Swimming WA. For existing SWA members to transfer into Swan Hills Swimming Club during 2014/2015 season (also need to complete a transfer form).

VOLUNTEER AGREEMENT 2014/2015

The sport of swimming relies heavily on volunteers during the running of swim meets. From club level through to state level, swimmer's parents are rostered to perform various duties on the day of the meet. Without the assistance of volunteers, meets cannot run smoothly and timely.

The following points are of importance:-

- ◆ If you have entered your child in a swim meet, expect to be rostered for timekeeping or any other related duty as specified by the Meet Director.
- ◆ Timekeeping slots do not always coincide with the times that your child is swimming and may occur once your child has completed his/her events.
- ◆ The numbers of volunteer slots are allocated according to the number of swims per club and not the number of swimmers or families.
- ◆ Volunteer rosters are emailed to members and published on the Swan Hills Swimming Club website, where possible.
- ◆ A volunteer roster will be available at the meet for checking. If you are not sure about volunteer duties, it is your responsibility to check with other Swan Hills parents or Swimming WA staff.
- ◆ It is the rostered parent's responsibility to arrange a substitute if they cannot do a specific time slot.
- ◆ If you are bringing another swimmer along to the meet and their parents are rostered, you will have to do their slot as well as your own.
- ◆ There will be times when you may be required to do additional slots than what was scheduled on the volunteer roster.
- ◆ It is the rostered parent's responsibility to ensure a reserve is arranged to do their slot.
- ◆ Once swimmers are legally able to drive themselves to swim meets, their parents will no longer be rostered for duties at minor race meets and club meet race sessions. However, they will be rostered for State Age and Open championships.
- ◆ Parents of swimmers who compete at State Age and Open Championship events, must also ensure they are available for timekeeping at the evening sessions if their child/ren have made it through to the finals.
- ◆ All members are encouraged to assist with club fundraising during the season.

Without timekeepers our swimmers cannot swim. If you do not honour your responsibility, you run the risk of having your child/ren's entries declined.
