

# CLEANING YOUR SNORKEL



Just a timely reminder that snorkels left unwashed and unsterilised for any length of time can grow mould and other “nasties” inside the tubing, which can be harmful to your health. Ideally you should clean them fortnightly and put them in clean, dry place after each use.

## Method:

- Remove all components (remembering how they go back together) and place in warm soapy water.
- Scrub outside surfaces with a sponge and the inside tubing with a long bottle brush.
- Rinse well and place in a plastic dish (not metal) containing 4L of cold water and 2 ½ capfuls of Milton or similar. Leave for a minimum of 15 minutes.
- Put back together and you’re ready to go.
